Change in ASPIRE Prohibited Medications

On September 19th the cIRB approved a revision to prohibited medications for ASPIRE.

Medications that are **combined P-gp and strong CYP3A34 inhibitors or inducers** are now classified as prohibited (*instead of discouraged*) for ASPIRE participants. This change means that patients who are unable to stop such medications cannot be enrolled in ASPIRE and subjects in the trial must temporarily hold the study drugs while taking them.

Please refer to **Prohibited and Discouraged Medication List v4** posted in WebDCU ASPIRE Toolbox for list of medications involved.

- Combined P-gp and strong CYP3A34 inducers include several antiseizure medications.
- **<u>Combined P-gp and strong CYP3A34 inhibitors</u>** include several antiviral and antifungal medications.

One prohibited medication is ritonavir, a component of Paxlovid. Subjects who are prescribed Paxlovid should be advised to stop taking their ASPIRE study medication (*both bottles*) at the start of their course of treatment and should resume taking them <u>4 days after the last dose of Paxlovid</u>. During the time off study medications, you may instruct your subjects to take aspirin 81 mg daily.

To alert ASPIRE participants of the need to hold study drug if they are prescribed a course of treatment, the **Paxlovid Letter to Participants** (*posted in Toolbox*) should be provided to and reviewed with each subject at their next scheduled study contact. As before, please remind ASPIRE subjects to contact you if they are prescribed any new medication.

Revisions to the **Concomitant Medications CRF** are in progress that will capture *all* prohibited medications. If a subject contact occurs before the new CRF is available and a new prohibited medication is being used, please make a note in the General Comments section of the CRF and follow the MOP for prohibited medications.
