



Reminders

- Blinded assessors need to be listed on your DOA. If you have questions about their trainings, please reach out to Kayla.
- Please use the consent checklist when consenting all subjects. If your site has a local checklist, please fill out both.
- Please print the 6 FusionHealth MOPs we have. They are located on our website and in the WebDCU Toolbox. These are great step by step guides on using KOEO, the T3, and CPAP.
- If you consent a subject, please obtain baseline information on them as soon as possible.



Scripts and myAir

- We have created scripts that are now CIRB approved. These scripts are designed
 to: (1) take the pressure off of the coordinators to know what to say at each stage of
 Sleep SMART, (2) standardize communication with subjects across sites, (3) provide
 information to participants in the most empathetic and motivating way. You can find
 the scripts in the WebDCU toolbox under Project documents. Please start to use
 them as soon as you are able to.
- myAir is an app that is freely available to intervention subjects to track their CPAP use and may be a valuable tool for them. The scripts will help you introduce the app to intervention subjects. Please offer to help subject or LAR enroll in MyAir (myair.resmed.com) so he or she can track PAP use independently
 *This is a ResMed app (subject to ResMed privacy policy) that participants can use for free because we're providing the ResMed S10 automatically adjusting CPAP device (MyAir not an official part of Sleep SMART)

Inpatient CPAP use

- Daily check-ins with intervention subject
 - Ask about any difficulties
 - Check front panel of PAP machine for usage hours and offer positive feedback to subject
 - Engage the RT or sleep tech for answers or solutions
- FusionHealth Care Team is available to discuss any problems and help troubleshoot, so feel free to reach out! Phone: 470-655-6688
- Praise the subject for small improvements
- Offer to help subject or LAR enroll in MyAir (myair.resmed.com) so he or she can track PAP use independently

3 and 6 month visits

The 3-month mRS is a primary outcome for Sleep SMART. Please complete all 3-month assessments within window, which has now been expanded. The target is still 90 days from randomization, but the window now runs from -30 days to +30 days. The earlier start for this window is designed to take better advantage of any opportunities for overlap with post-hospitalization follow-up visits scheduled for clinical purposes. However, the outcome assessments can be done by phone, if necessary, and should be completed by a blinded assessor if possible. Participants receive \$75 for the 3-month assessment, and \$75 for the 6-month assessment!!
