# Mask Guidance

As a reminder, there is no recall related to the ResMed magnet-containing masks including the N20 and F20. Nonetheless, to avoid future concerns about magnet-containing masks, and to simplify mask selection procedures, we have decided to phase out all magnet-containing masks at sites.

Please continue to use your current supply of ResMed masks (P10, N20, and F20), using the current mask selection protocols, and referencing the safety considerations in the mask MOPs. When you need replacements for the N20 and F20 masks, magnet-free masks will be provided. To summarize the replacement plan, this is what you will receive when you re-order specific masks:

#### Order this: P10 N20 F20

#### **Receive this:**

P10 (this is already magnet-free) ResMed Airfit N30i Fisher & Paykel Evora full face mask

## **S10** supplies

- Please use up your S10 supplies and dispense your last S10 run in night device to an intervention subject when your S10 supplies are almost depleted
- KOEO does not have separate pathways to order S10 vs S11 supplies. Until that is available, when you order humidifier basins or tubing, please email sleepsmarttechsupport@noxhealth.com to specify whether you are ordering for the S10 or S11.
- Only order S10 supplies if you have a mismatch in the number of remaining S10 tubes and basins. If you have more basins than tubes, you'll need that many extra tubes. If you have more tubes than basins, you'll need that many additional basins. If you have the same number of S10 tubes and basins, you won't need to order any additional S10 tubes or basins.
- Fusion will send you a run-in night sticker. When you have dispensed your last S10 run-in night device, please place the sticker on a new S11 that you designate as the run-in night device.
