














# **Total Enrollment by Site**












# **Total Enrollment by Site**














# **Total Enrollment by RCC**

### **SATURN MRI: Introduction**

### **Study Purpose**


This ancillary study is looking to determine the effects of continuation versus discontinuation of statin therapy on the incidence of new cerebral small vessel disease markers that are detected through the MRI scanning technique.

#### **MRI** scans

- 1. **At time of enrollment.** If an MRI was obtained for clinical purposes after the qualifying brain hemorrhage presentation, this may be used as the first scan (provided that it complies with study imaging protocol). If not, the subject can undergo the MRI within ±7 days of randomization.
- 2. At the end of participation. Once the subject has reached the end of their study participation, they will return to the enrolling institution for the final scan. This MRI can be done within 30 days of the 2 year end-study visit and subjects will be reimbursed for transportation and/or parking expenses.

#### **Consent Process**

Consent for SATURN MRI is included as an optional section in the newest version of the SATURN Informed Consent Form (version 6). Subjects can choose to opt-in to participate in SATURN MRI when consenting for SATURN.

# **SATURN MRI: How to recruit subjects**

### **Eligibility**

Participants in SATURN MRI must meet all SATURN eligibility criteria, in addition to:

- 1. Subject or surrogate provides signed informed consent and opt to participate in the MRI study.
- Subject has no known contraindications to MRI such as claustrophobia, metal implants, or pacemaker.


### Retroactively screening already enrolled SATURN patients

Sites which participate in SATURN MRI and received their cIRB approved ICF version 6 should contact all of their subjects to inform them about the ancillary study and re-consent with new ICF in case patient is willing to be enrolled

If the enrolled subject had a MRI at the time of the qualifying ICH, but the site did not upload it to WebDCU, you can send us the MRI now & try to enroll the subject in SATURN MRI.

### **Enrolling new SATURN patients**

Sites which participate in SATURN MRI and received their cIRB approved ICF version 6 should include information about the MRI study in their SATURN enrollment conversation and have the patient opt-in or opt-out before signing the consent form.













# **Updates and Reminders**

### **Lab Kit Receiving and Blood Shipping**

Please log the receipt of the tubes/lab kits within 5 days of receiving them.

Once you are ready to ship the blood sample, remember to fill out the Shipping Specimen to Central Lab form.

### **REDCap Subject Contact Information Updates**

Please review all of your active subjects, and confirm that ALL information is correct and complete on REDCap. Make sure date of birth, pronouns, complete mailing addresses and alternative contacts are listed. This information is essential to the central assessors when completing follow-up visits.

### **Delegation of Authorities (DOA)**

Remember to keep your DOA up to date by adding new members, deleting inactive ones, and updating responsibilities. Also, please edit any additional information such as emails, phone numbers and addresses if they change.

### **Neuroimaging File Collection**

A maximum of 3 scans should be uploaded on WebDCU at the 'Baseline' visit:

- 1. The first CT scan acquired after hemorrhage
- 2. MRI/MRA if one is acquired
- 3. CTA if acquired

The date on the scans should match the date entered on the CRF.


