

Enrollment Updates




"It's wonderful to see 9 sites released to enroll and over a dozen patients enrolled. We are on our way to asking some critically important questions to advance stroke".




Study Reminders

- FM assessor and participant/family should be blinded to the MEP status
 - Never reveal MEP status or MRI findings to stroke participants. This is a research study, and sharing such data with participants could bias outcomes.
- For TMS data collection, please use the TMS form located in the studybook/source documentation packet. This studybook/source documentation packet v4.0 is available in the Toolbox tab of WebDCU.
- Please make sure initial acute clinical neuroimaging is uploaded (CT/CTA/CTP or MRI/MRA/MRP) to Ambra, as well as the standard of care (SOC) MRI and study specific 24hr+ MRI (if differs from SOC MRI).

TMS Reminders

- The TMS Protocol has been updated to make training & study conduct easier! All sites no longer need to do the 30 "keeper" frames from both healthy volunteers (training) & stroke participants. Please refer to the TMS VERIFY website for more details.

- Some other effects of changing the TMS protocol:
 - The TMS training website and quizzes have been updated accordingly
 - All documents on the TMS training website have been updated accordingly
 - A new module 9 with information specific to doing TMS with VERIFY stroke patients has been added to the training website. There is no quiz for this module
 - The REDCap forms have been updated accordingly
 - WebDCU has not been updated yet so please ignore questions on WebDCU that aren't on the source document- we will let you know when this is updated.



Consent Reminders

- In VERIFY, an impartial witness should be used if the participant is unable to read or cannot sign/date their name due to the effects of their stroke.
- An impartial witness **CANNOT** be a study team member, friend, or family member of the participant.
