Current WG Role

- 1. To provide scientific and design input to the PPIs regarding trial concepts prior to submission to NINDS for concept approval when requested by NINDS or directly by PPIs
- 2. To provide feasibility assessment of NINDS-approved concepts when activated by NINDS
 - 1. Estimate how many subjects StrokeNET can enroll per year at how many sites?
 - Use survey data for hard numbers and then make further calculations based on epidemiology assessment, literature, and clinical judgment
 - 2. Provide those recs to the StrokeNET Executive Committee
- 3. To assess gaps in the field and provide guidance regarding Acute Stroke clinical trial issues (including potentially growing clinical trials to fill those gaps from within StrokeNET)

PPI FAOS

- Joe and NCC staff will assist you in developing your grant budget based on StrokeNET infrastructural support.

- Two rounds of NINDS CDE input
- Trial discussions
 - Pre-"concept approval" reviews of trials
 - MOST, IMPACT
 - Feasibility assessments (post concept approval)
 - DEFUSE 3, ICTUS 3, MOST, DEFUSE 3 resubmission, IDEF (funded trial)

DEFUSE 3 Trial

PI: Albers

- Phase III trial of endovascular therapy vs medical mgmt (+/- IV rtPA) in MRI-selected patients
- Activities to date
 - Feasibility assessment of first submission
 - Feasibility assessment of resubmission
- Updates
 - Design updated based on MR CLEAN results
 - Planned resubmission to NIH in March
 - Any other quick updates?

ICTUS 3 Trial

PI: Lyden, Hemmen, Grotta

- Phase III trial of hypothermia for acute ischemic stroke patients
- Activities to date
 - Feasibility assessment
- Updates
 - Submitted to NIH in October grant cycle
 - Updates from Lyden:
 - There are plans to amend protocol to allow endovascular therapy
 - ICTUS (n=120) DSMB review in March
 - Completing basic science studies of 33 vs 35 degrees F as target temperature

MOST Trial

- Phase III trial of antithrombotics (eptafibatide or argatroban for IV rtPA treated patients)
- Activities to date
 - Pre-concept approval input
 - Feasibility assessment
 - Post MR CLEAN/endo results input
- Updates
 - Submitted to NIH in October grant cycle
 - Any quick updates?

IMPACT Trial

PI: Naidech

- Phase 2b trial of desmopressin for antiplatelet-treated ICH patients
- Activities
 - Pre-concept approval input
- Update
 - Prelim budget being developed with NCC staff and then concept will be submitted to NINDS
 - Any quick updates?
